great country song that makes me think of Angel, my wife, is "Forever After All" by Luke Combs. The lyrics compare the transience of things in this world — things like "Duracells in a Maglite," "blue jeans after years of shift work" and "the strings on this guitar" — to genuine human love.

Yet nothing lasts forever in the human realm. What's here today is gone tomorrow. Think about your own experience. What's changed for you in your family over the last 10 years? What about the last five years? Or even since last week?

Do you live in the same place you did 10 years ago? Do you have the same job? The same bank account balance? The same haircut, clothing, hobbies and health status? Chances are, a lot has changed for you over time.

The impermanence of life certainly holds true in sports, as well. One day, a baseball player goes 4 for 5 with two home runs and six RBIs. The next day, he whiffs three times. The roster of your favorite team doesn't look the same this year as it did last season. Even the glow of final victory quickly fades: All championship teams start the next season 0-0.

This constant change can feel jarring. Yet there is one thing we can pursue that will last forever: God's glory. When we put away our selfish pursuits and seek to build God's Kingdom and bring Him praise in all we do, we will experience something this world can never offer us. In 1 Corinthians 9:25, Paul says, "Now everyone who competes exercises self-control in everything. They do it to receive a perishable crown, but we an imperishable crown." The word "imperishable" means enduring, not subject to decay — something that lasts forever. Imperishable glory is true glory!

What kind of glory are you chasing in life? Whose kingdom are you building in your family, work, hobbies and other activities? Are you grasping at glory that will quickly diminish like the power of a battery, the strings of a guitar or the luster of a championship trophy? Or are you pursuing the lasting glory of the eternal God who made all things, including time itself?

As Hebrews 12:1-2 says, "Let us lay aside every hindrance and the sin that so easily ensnares us. Let us run with endurance the race that lies before us, keeping our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of our faith. For the joy that lay before him, he endured the cross, despising the shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."





THE LASTING CB L C R Y OF GOD



his year, FCA has been taking coaches and athletes on a marvelous journey to discover God's glory and how they can use athletic competition to glorify Him above all.

Throughout the year, we have focused on four main components of glory:

- · Chasing Glory (Isaiah 43:7)
- · Revealed Glory (John 1:14)
- Reflecting Glory (2 Corinthians 3:18)
- · Lasting Glory (Matthew 6:33)

As we end 2025, we are focusing on Lasting Glory, seeking God's Kingdom first and experiencing the true joy and purpose that this brings. Matthew 6:33 says, "But seek first

the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you

But how do we seek first the Kingdom of God? How do we pursue His Lasting Glory?

FROM, THROUGH AND TO GOD

In Romans 11:36, the apostle Paul writes, "For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be the glory forever. Amen."

All things are from God, through God and to God. That list is comprehensive: Everything in life — including our hopes, dreams, goals and daily activities — are for God, through God and to God. What is Paul's conclusion as he considers all this? "To him be the glory

forever." That's Lasting Glory.

This eternal perspective is what keeps us pointed in the right direction in the present, especially during the hardships we face on this side of eternity. Our present trials in no way diminish God's glory or our experience of it. As Paul says so well, "For our momentary light affliction is producing for us an absolutely incomparable eternal weight of glory" (2 Corinthians 4:17).

He's talking about the Lasting Glory of God's future Kingdom — a new Heaven and new Earth where we will enjoy resurrected, physical and glorified bodies forever. This hope is the fuel that helps us



carry on. In God's often mysterious goodness and power, even the hardships and sufferings of this age are working toward a future eternal glory for us to experience and enjoy.

Just as we admonish our competitors to dig deep and not quit when things are hard, we should also admonish one another to do the same in God's Kingdom. We dig deep into the well of God's provision of strength, empowerment and hope to persevere until the end.

LIVING SACRIFICES

Immediately after pointing us to God's Lasting Glory in Romans 11:36, Paul writes the following: "Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship. Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God" (12:1-2).

A living sacrifice is a paradoxical yet amazing word picture for describing life in the Kingdom of God. We put to death those things in us that need to die, and we also willingly sacrifice good things, like time and money, for the good of others. Paul says this is our worship, our submission to God's reign and our way of giving glory to Him.

Presenting our bodies as living sacrifices for God's glory is a lifelong pursuit. There will be mountains, valleys, smooth roads, and rutted, muddy paths. But as we pursue Christ, we can be "encouraged, comforted, and implored ... to walk worthy of God, who calls you into his own kingdom and glory" (1 Thessalonians 2:12).

OUR HOPE

FCA's desire is that every coach and athlete we encounter would flourish in their relationship with God as they seek His Lasting Glory. We want them to be sharpened to look more like Jesus, just as we desire that for ourselves. This spiritual character-building is preparing us for a glory that lasts when we look like Jesus and offer praise and glory to God through how we live, what we think and say, and how we compete. Though training is hard, it's worth it in the long run as we are strengthened and our perseverance is developed in Him.

"Therefore," Paul writes in 2 Corinthians 4:16-17, "we do not give up. Even though our outer person is being destroyed, our inner person is being renewed day by day. For our momentary light affliction is producing for us an absolutely incomparable eternal weight of glory."

HIGHLIGHTS FCA





In 2025, FCA celebrated its 71st remarkable year of ministry, growth and God's blessings.



Holding fast to the FCA Vision and Mission, the number of FCA staff, international leaders and Huddles grew this year. FCA now has 3.175 staff and 81 international leaders serving 23,210 Huddles globally. The ministry serves 68 countries outside the U.S.



As a faith-funded ministry, we give thanks to the Lord for His provision. FCA received \$246 million* in contribution revenue, a 1.7% growth from last year.



The Automatic Monthly Partner (AMP) program reached over \$82 million* in revenue, a 22.4% increase over the prior year, making up 33.3% of FCA's total donors.



Through a partnership with YouVersion, FCA has published over 224 Bible reading plans in 14 languages and currently has more than 2.55 million subscriptions and over 1.39 million completions of its reading plans.



The CORE is a simple, relevant resource to confidently disciple a new believer through eight core essentials of the Christian faith. This past year, The CORE sold 29,451 copies and its website had 14,000 visitors.



The FOUR is FCA's Gospel presentation that helps competitors understand the truth of God's Word in four simple steps. This past year, The FOUR's website had 61,000 visitors.



FCA distributed 244,650 Bibles around the world.



FCA's Daily Impact Play devotional email saw an 11% increase in new subscriptions with over 6,000. This daily email helps equip Christian competitors.



In fiscal year 2025, 529 staff participated in Boot Camp, a two-day fundraising training. This was a 10% increase over 2024. FCA's diversity index for these participants is 54%, which is 5% higher than the past fiscal year.



FCA has 18 consecutive 4-Star top ratings from Charity Navigator, America's largest organization rating the fiscal management of charities. This puts FCA in the top 1% of all charities rated.



FCA.org saw around 1.1 million page visits from more than 446,000 users, with users from 199 countries accessing the site. This highlights FCA's global reach, engagement and growing online presence.



FCA's Global Impact internship program completed its fourth year as 64 interns (39 from the U.S. and 25 from around the world) and 22 FCA staff (and spouses) representing 13 different countries were commissioned and sent to six different global locations.
